

2018 Party on the Pavement - Saturday, September 22, 2018 Not-For-Profit Exhibitor Application

NON-PROFIT DESIGNATION: The non-profit category is reserved for service groups, charities, foundations and other organizations for purposes of distributing information or sponsoring a fund raising event to benefit the non-profit. If your Not-For-Profit organization wants to serve food and beverages, please fill out the Food Vendor Application. There are not Not-For-Profit rates for Food Vendors. If you are a reseller of goods, local business or independent consultant, see Commercial Vendor Application.

☐ Not-For-Profit Exhibitors are not allowed to conduct 50/50 raffles or raffles for cash prizes.
☐ Not-For-Profit Exhibitors are encouraged to have fund raising activities (ie. face painting, ring toss, temporary
tattoos, games, etc.) to raise funds.

WHERE: Downtown Racine, Main and Sixth Streets

WHEN: Saturday, September 22, 2018 – 12:00 pm – 7:00 pm

SET-UP: 8:00 am Day of Festival. Vehicles MUST be moved out of Festival grounds by 11:00 am on the day of the Festival.

DEADLINE: All applications must be submitted by August 24, 2018

BOOTH SPACE: Booth space is limited to a single 12' x 12' booth (including all wires, stakes, poles, etc.) Vendors should come prepared for all types of weather. You must secure your booth in case of inclement conditions.

EXHIBIT: All items being exhibited or displayed MUST be contained in the booth space assigned. No items, solicitation, or set-up shall take place outside the assigned booth space.

WEATHER: The Festival will not be cancelled because of rain. This is an outdoor event; be prepared for any type of weather. Tents, canopies and pop-ups must be secured to withstand the weather.

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE: A current Certificate of Insurance is required for all vendors naming Downtown Racine Corporation as an additional insured. The Certificate of Insurance is required before set-up.

REQUIREMENTS: The exhibitor will be responsible to be open during the entire Festival. You cannot vacate early. Your booth must be neat, attractive and well-maintained. You are responsible for setting up, maintaining, and removing your own booth, your merchandise and your trash.

GENERAL INFORMATION - Procedures, Conditions & Rates

This document contains pertinent rules and regulations that govern the operations of Party on the Pavement (POP) sponsored and hosted by the Downtown Racine Corporation (DRC).

We are extending invitations to exhibitors who submit fully executed applications with required enclosures and payments (see application page) by the August 24, 2018 deadline. Priorities for space will be reviewed based on past participation, date of receipt of fully executed application and type of exhibit/activity.

DRC strives to maintain a balance and diversity in exhibitor offerings. All exhibitors and applications are reviewed so that we may maintain this balance. Our goal is to keep standards high and promote a safe, successful and fun Festival. The policies and regulations set forth in this document are designed to maintain order and to regulate activities on the Festival site. Regulations will be enforced.

*** The fee for Not-For-Profits is \$150.00, however, if your Not-For-Profit is willing to supply us with **12** volunteer hours for the day of Party on the Pavement, your fee will be waived. Shifts on the day of the event are typically 2 hours long and you may break those shifts up into as many or as few volunteers as you like. Please submit a check for the \$150 booth fee, which we will not deposit unless volunteer hours fail to be completed. Your check will be returned to you upon completion of the hours. Interested parties should contact Kelly Kruse at kkruse@racinedowntown.com for further instruction.

PROCEDURES

The following application and agreement must be fully completed, signed and returned with the following enclosures in order to be considered for participation:

- 1. Detailed list of all proposed activities taking place at the requested Not-For-Profit booth space.
- \$150.00 vendor fee with a completed and signed application by August 24, 2018. If the Not-For-Profit exhibitor fee is not paid by August 24, 2018, the exhibitor fee will be \$250. If you are not accepted for the Festival, your check will be returned to you by August 31st, 2018.
- 3. Certificate of Insurance naming Downtown Racine Corporation as an additional insured.
- 4. Signed and dated AFFIRMATION & LIABILITY RELEASE

CONDITIONS

- 1. All locations will be assigned by DRC staff and POP volunteers. While written location requests will be considered, placement will be at the sole discretion of DRC staff and POP volunteers. Use of Festival space is strictly limited to assigned location.
- 2. With the exception of specified setup/load-in and breakdown/load-out times, vehicles will not be permitted in the event site. Vehicles will be removed immediately when asked to be by DRC staff and POP volunteers.
- 3. No Exhibitor Shall:
 - a. Attract attention to his booth by hawking or crying out.
 - b. Allow any waste, garbage or any other refuse to remain in or near his space after the closing hours of the POP Festival.
- 4. Exhibitors are not to begin striking their display until Saturday at 7:00 p.m. Booths must remain open until event closing. Leaving early makes the Festival look in disarray; and exhibitors who leave early will not be invited to participate the following year.
